



## 2011-12 WSOP CIRCUIT CUMULATIVE PLAYER POINT SYSTEM CHART & EXPLANATION

4 WAYS TO QUALIFY; 100 PLAYERS WILL QUALIFY, 66 VIA POINT TOTAL

### OVERVIEW

- The 2011-12 WSOP Circuit Event tour will use a *Cumulative Player Point System* to track player success in all official WSOP Circuit open gold ring events.
- Players earn points at each WSOP Circuit stop in the United States.
- You must cash in an official WSOP ring event to earn points.
- All buy-ins for official preliminary ring events (from \$300-\$1,000 buy-in) award points in the same manner.
- All buy-ins for official Main Event (\$1,600 level) award points differently and higher than preliminary ring events.

### QUALIFICATION DETAILS

There are 4 different ways to qualify for the **WSOP National Championship**. They are:

1. **Automatic:** Win the \$1,600 Main Event at any WSOP Circuit event. (1 per stop; 17 players total)
2. **Automatic:** Be the "Casino Champion" accumulating the most points at any of the individual WSOP Circuit stops' 12 official "ring" events. (1 per stop; 17 players total)
3. **Accumulate Points:** Accumulate enough points between all the WSOP Circuit stops to be positioned in the Top 66 cumulative point standings at the end of the 2011-12 WSOP Circuit tour.\*
4. **Buy-In:** Be one of the top 100 players in the new "WSOP World Rankings" and have the chance to buy-into the event for \$10,000 a seat. The World Rankings will recognize cumulative performance in open events at the World Series of Poker and World Series of Poker Europe over a two-year period and be released in November, 2011, following the November Nine.
