Gregory Hartwick Wins First WSOP Circuit Gold Ring

Canadian Tops \$500 Buy-In NLHE Event at Caesars Palace Las Vegas

Las Vegas, NV (January 23, 20112) – The World Series of Poker Circuit continued today at Caesars Palace Las Vegas.

The latest tournament champion is Gregory Hartwick, from Bolton, Ontario (Canada). He won his first gold ring, in what amounted to his first-time ever to cash on the WSOP Circuit. Hartwick collected a nice payout, totaling \$26,106 in prize money.

Hartwicks poker resume includes two previous cashes in WSOP events played in Las Vegas. He cashed in two \$1,500 buy-in events, played in 2008 and 2009. However, this was his biggest score, to date and marked his sixth major tournament cash overall. Remarkably, this was the first WSOP Circuit event Hartwick had ever played.

Hartwick is a 40-year-old customs broker. He is originally from Toronto.

Play began on Sunday at noon and concluded in a relatively quick time, concluding during the late afternoon during Day Two on Monday.

The total prize pool came to \$100,395. The top 21 finishers were paid. All players who cashed received WSOP Circuit National Championship ranking points . used to qualify for a seat in the season-ending championship, to be played in Las Vegas.

MORE ABOUT THE WSOP CIRCUIT AT CAESARS PALACE

This marks the seventh consecutive year that Caesars Palace Las Vegas is hosting the widely-popular World Series of Poker Circuit, which is currently in the midst of its most successful

season. Attendance is currently running about 20 percent ahead of last year (which set a record).
