"Practice Makes Perfect" Allen Kemp Wins Event 9 at Harrah's Tunica

Playing in his first-ever live tournament, 33-year-old IT specialist turns "practice" session into \$36,780

Amateurs continue to dominate through nine Events at Harrah's Tunica

TUNICA, MS – The World Series of Poker Circuit Events at Harrah's Tunica continued Friday with the conclusion of Event 9, \$580 No-Limit Hold'em. The winner was Allen Kemp, a 33-year-old IT specialist from Hartsville, TN.

Kemp, who won a seat to the 2013 WSOP Main Event at his local home game, decided to make the trip to Harrah's Tunica to prepare himself for the big dance this summer in Las Vegas.

"This was a good practice session," Kemp said after the win. "I came into this just hoping not to embarrass myself."

So other than \$36,780 in first place prize money and the WSOP Circuit Gold ring what did Kemp come away with from his "practice" session?

"You gotta stay focused," he said. "I've never played this long before, so focus is the key."

With seven of nine events so far going to amateurs, this year's WSOP Circuit series at Harrah's Tunica has been a testament to why poker's popularity is ever-increasing. With even just a small investment of time and money, anyone with the aptitude to analyze situations and make good decisions can take a seat and compete with the best of them.

Event #9, \$580 No-Limit Hold'em drew 313 entries, generating a total prize pool of \$156,500. The top 33 finishers made the money.

Through nine events, John Holley, a professional fisherman and poker player from Destin, FL maintained the lead in the Casino Champion points race at Harrah's Tunica with a total of 90 points.

The Casino Champion is the player who earns the most points through the 12 events at Harrah's Tunica. This player will earn an automatic seat to the WSOP Circuit National Championship to be held May 21 – May 23 at Harrah's New Orleans.
