Charles-Andrew Sylvestre of Quebec, Canada joins Daniel Negreanu as the second player this year to win a bracelet after taking down Event 3 of the 44th Annual WSOP. Sylvestre beat a large field in a \$1,500 re-entry event to earn \$491,360.

Sylvestre had some impressive company on his rail, as 2010 WSOP Main Event Champion Jonathan Duhamel was on hand to cheer his friend and fellow countryman on at a final table that featured notable Circuit success stories like Ping Liu (9th), Darren Rabinowitz (7th), and Ryan Olisar (6th), who managed to remarkably final table this event for the second year in a row, having finished 4th in 2012.
