After years of noteworthy results but no WSOP victories, Matthew Waxman can finally call himself a bracelet winner. The Florida poker pro defeated a large field in Event 7, a \$1,000 No Limit Hold'em event, to win over \$300,000 and a shiny new piece of hardware.

It might be the most hard-fought victory of Waxman's career as he and bracelet winner Eric Baldwin battled back and forth in a remarkable heads-up match that lasted six hours and nearly 200 hands. The chip lead changed numerous times over, but each time the short-stacked player managed to battle back. After a seemingly endless bout, Waxman eventually prevailed to claim his first WSOP win.
