The third time was a charm for Brent Wheeler who won his first WSOP gold bracelet on the heels of his third final table appearance early Thursday morning. In addition to the trophy, Wheeler was awarded \$191,605 for his victory in the \$1,500 Limit Hold'em event.

A poker pro from St. Charles, IL, Wheeler previously finished fourth and seventh in limit and mixed-hold'em events at the WSOP. In Thursday's victory, though, he crushed the hopes of the Canadian hopeful eying their fourth gold bracelet victory of the 2013 WSOP by outlasting Mark Mierkalns heads-up.
