At a final table with bracelet winners and accomplished pros, it was the player with just a single WSOP cash to his credit who triumphed and won the bracelet Thursday night in the \$2,500 Six-Handed No Limit Hold'em Event.

Twenty-two year old Levi Berger of Los Angeles bested two-time gold bracelet winner Scott Clements heads-up to win his first bracelet at his first WSOP final table. He also earned \$473,019. The bracelet continues the hot streak fro Canadian players as Berger, who classifies himself as a poker pro, originally hails from Ottowa, Canada.

This win marks the fourth of the summer for Canada through 12 events. He joins fellow countrymen Charles-Andrew Sylvestre, Benny Chen, and Michael Malm on the list of 2013 bracelet winner from Canada.
