If one delves into his resume, though, they'd find he's one of the most decorated champions the WSOP has ever seen. Yes, the man they call "The Mouth" has a way of making sure you hear about his misfortunes...but Event 13 was all about his triumphs.

Matusow won the \$5,000 Seven Card Stud Hi-Low Split-8 or Better event that included a who's who of poker professionals. In addition to \$266,503, he earned his fourth gold bracelet. The victory moves him into an elite club of four-time champions that includes Puggy Pearson, Amarillo Slim, Bobby Baldwin, Huck Seed and a handful of other WSOP legends.
