Tom Schneider won two gold bracelets en route to earning Player of the Year honors back at the 2007 World Series of Poker. In the time since he's recorded a formidable 24 WSOP-related cashes, but his highest finish is a mere fifth place, well short of the bar he set for himself just six years ago.

It's 2013 now, and Schneider is back to his winning ways. The 53-year-old pro from Scottsdale, Ariz. broke through for gold bracelet victory number three in Event 15, a \$1,500 H.O.R.S.E. tournament, early Monday morning. He outlasted some of the game's best and earned \$258,960 for his efforts.
