Two years after capturing his first WSOP Bracelet, Greek poker pro Athanasios Polychronopoulos struck gold once again late Monday night after winning Event 17, \$1,500 No-Limit Hold'em.

The 29-year-old former restauranteur defeated Manuel Mutke of Germany to claim his second WSOP title, worth \$518,755. Both of Polychronopoulos' bracelets have come in \$1,500 No-Limit Hold'em Events and he now has of excess of \$1.27 million in WSOP earnings. He is the first player in WSOP history to win two large field events with buy-ins of \$1,500 or less.
