Davidi Kitai won Event 19, a \$5,000 Pot-Limit Hold'em event, at the 2013 World Series of Poker early Wednesday morning besting Cary Katz heads-up. The33-year-old Belgium-based professional is best known for being one of just a handful of players to complete poker's Triple Crown by earning a WSOP gold bracelet as well as WPT and EPT titles.

With that achievement already under his belt, he added to his WSOP legend by becoming a two-time gold bracelet champion and pocketing \$224,560 in the process. Kitai won his first gold bracelet in 2008 also in a pot-limit hold'em event, and in the years since he'searned 15 additional WSOP cashes as well as his WPT and EPT titles.
