At just 22 years old, Martin Finger's poker resume would make even some of the most successful pros blush. Prior to Event 21 at the 2013 World Series of Poker, though, his resume had one gaping hole -- a WSOP gold bracelet.

Fortunately for the battle-tested pro, that all changed in the \$3,000 No-Limit Hold'em Six-Handed event. He outlasted fellow professional Matt Stout in an epic, back-and-forth heads-up battle to win his first bracelet along with \$506,764. Additionally, the victory moves him over the \$2 million mark in tournament earnings and inches him closer to earning poker's Triple Crown (WSOP, WPT and EPT victories).
