After a lightning fast start to the day, it ended up being a crawl to the finish line for the latest gold bracelet winner Corey Harrison. The third and final day of play in the \$1,500 No Limit Hold'em Event 24 at the WSOP sped to a final table in lightning speed, but the final table itself was a long one, lasting over 200 hands before Harrison emerged victorious with a bracelet and a \$432,411 payday.

The 36-year-old college professor from Birmingham, Alabama got a lesson in patience to go along with his big cash prize, as the slow pace of the final table tested all the players' mental toughness and fortitude. Harrison spends his days teaching students, but does find time to play some cards. This is second career WSOP cash, with his first coming in another \$1,500 buy-in No Limit Event last week where he took 29th place.
