Since he is a country western singer in addition to a poker pro, it only seems appropriate to declare that Tom Schneider is back in the saddle again.

It is also fitting that his second victory of the summer comes in the HORSE event. If this story sounds familiar, it should. Less than a week ago, Schneider won the \$1,500 HORSE event along with \$258,000. Now he has swept the HORSE events on the 2013 WSOP schedule, winning the \$5,000 HORSE tournament, a fourth gold bracelet, and a \$318,955 payday.

Schneider, who won the 2007 WSOP Player of the Year title, is now one of the frontrunners to take that crown this year. He is the first two-time winner of the year and is now less than 20 points away from catching another former WSOP Player of the Year, Daniel Negreanu, who now maintains the lead by only the slimmest of margins.

This second win for Schneider also continues the now 14-year streak of at least one player winning multiple gold bracelets in a single year.
