Michael Moore outlasted a stacked final table to win Event 37, a \$5,000 Limit Hold'em tournament, and earn his first gold bracelet early Sunday morning.

The man they call "Big Store" has been around the World Series of Poker for some time, most notably finishing tenth in the 1995 Main Event, but didn't bring the accolades to the table that many of his fellow final tablists did. Still though, Moore persevered and beat out Gabriel Nassif heads-up to cash in \$211,743.
