The good times kept rolling for the United States' neighbor to the north Sunday night as Canadian Justin Oliver outlasted American Nick Schwarmann to win the \$2,500 No-Limit Hold'em Four-Handed event.

The victory came on the heels of an epic comeback performance by Oliver who was short stacked during much of the late stages of play. The 37-year-old Toronto-based jeweler and poker player earned \$309,071 and, of course, his first gold bracelet.

Impressively, the victory marks the eighth time for a Canadian-born winner to be crowned at this summer's series and the ninth time in 2013, including Daniel Negreanu's World Series of Poker APAC Main Event win.
