Jared "The Waco Kidd" Hamby impressively parlayed his final table short stack into a comeback of a gold bracelet victory Monday night at the 44th Annual World Series of Poker. Hamby's win came in Event 40, a \$1,500 buy-in No-Limit Hold'em tournament, and he collected \$525,272 in prize money.

Hamby is best known for his online success as one of the original pioneers of the then-relatively-unknown phenomenon of internet poker. He made quite a name for himself, amassing six figures worth of career earnings on the online felt, but his live resume is nothing to shake a stick at either.

Hamby's most recent score marks his 19th WSOP cash and third final table appearance. The first place prize money boosts his career earnings at the WSOP to just under \$1 million. He is a 31-year-old professional poker player from Elkhart, Ind.
