Over 40 events into this year's World Series of Poker, only a handful of nations have earned bracelets. While the United States and Canada have been cleaning up, other nations like Great Britain and France have gone winless. Today though, another country got on the board for bracelet wins, as Norbert Szecsi of Hungary picked up the European country's fourth bracelet in WSOP history.

Szecsi bested the final table of the \$1,000 No Limit Hold'em Event 42 final table in a matter of hours after a series of dramatic all-ins propelled him to a victory worth \$345,037. The 22-year-old poker player from Budapest was at his first final table with a rail of eager supporters, including last year's October Niner, Hungarian Andras Koroknai.
