Ontario's Kristen Bicknell collected the tenth gold bracelet for Canada this summer after taking down the Ladies No Limit Hold'em Championship event. In what was her first-ever WSOP cash and first final table appearance, Bicknell defeated Leslie Haas, who was looking to win another bracelet for the country of Australia. Bicknell collected \$173,922 for first, while Haas earned a tidy sum of \$107,616 for the runner-up finish.

The win extends the record number of bracelets for a non-American country to ten. Throwing Daniel Negreanu's APAC Main Event win into the tally, that makes 11 bracelets in 2013 for the Northern powerhouse.
