The story of the tortoise and the hare teaches us that, oftentimes, slow and steady wins the race. That is the case today as Brett Shaffer, a 30 year old from Beloit, Kansas, defeated a field of more than 2,800 players to win his first bracelet as well as \$665,397.

Shaffer made the final table of the \$1,500 No Limit Hold'em Event 53 along with a number of more experienced pros like David Vamplew, Loni Harwood, and Mike Watson. Rather than immediately make a rash decision or shove all in and hope for the best, Shaffer took his time, worked his way through his decisions, and ended up coming out of the event with a gold bracelet.

Shaffer defeated Scottish pro David Vamplew heads-up for the title at what was his second career WSOP final table. He previously finished sixth in the \$1,500 No Limit Hold'em Shootout event in 2010.
