Mashantucket, CT (August 10, 2013) — A total of 116 players ponied up the \$1,125 for the second event in the Foxwoods WSOP Circuit Series. The field was filled with seasoned Circuit grinders as well as Foxwoods regulars.

At the end of Day 1, the field had been trimmed to the final ten. Those ten players bagged their chips and returned today to play down to a winner. William Krooss-Tadas held a massive chip lead with 541,000 while second place Michael Xifaras sat on 222,000.

The final day of play took less than three hours to complete. With only four players remaining, Fabio D'Agata got all-in before the flop with pocket kings against the As-Qs of Brandon Thomas. Thomas flopped a queen plus two spades but D'Agata was able to fade all of Thomas' outs to win the huge pot and eliminate Thomas from the tournament. At that point, D'Agata held nearly half the chips in play.

Just moments later, D'Agata won another huge pot off of Krooss-Tadas to take control of nearly 90% of the chips in play. It was just a few hands later that D'Agata was able to finish off both of his opponents to take the title.

D'Agata had planned on playing the entire series to make a run at the Casino Champion title but the unexpected death of his grandmother changed his plans. D'Agata is now leaving Monday for Italy for the funeral and will be unable to play any more events during this series.

He stated that he is glad that he had the opportunity to play at least the first two events and will be back on the Circuit after he returns in a few weeks.

D'Agata is a Foxwoods regular who cut his teeth in the poker room downstairs. He said that his time grinding here with WSOP bracelet winner and close friend, Ronnie Bardah, gave his the tools necessary to take down such a title.

While he won't be making a run at the Casino Championship, look for Fabio D'Agata to return to the Circuit shortly and continue his hot streak.

Congratulations again to Fabio D'Agata, winner of the \$1,125 No-Limit Hold 'em event at the Foxwoods Resort Casino Circuit.
