Jeffrey Evans Claims his First Circuit Ring Amateurs continue to dominate the HSI Circuit.

Elizabeth, IN (October 6, 2013) – The domination of the amateur continues at the Horseshoe Southern Indiana Circuit series. Jeffrey Evans just claimed his first WSOP Circuit cash and gold ring in the \$580 No-Limit Hold 'em event.

A total of 99 players entered the field for the \$580 No-Limit Hold 'em event at the Horseshoe Southern Indiana Circuit series. Less than 11 hours after play began, we were already at our nine-handed final table. Players broke for the night and play resumed at 2pm today.

While Sean Stevens held the chip lead coming into play on Day 2, Evans entered in second place. At the final table, Robert Georato was the only player with a Circuit ring. However, before two of the final table participants even showed up, Georato was knocked out in 9th place. After that, it took less than four hours to for Evans to dispose of his opponents.

The Peebles, OH native and self-employed excavator became the second player in a row to not only earn his first WSOP Circuit cash, but also his first ring.

While Evans is not a regular on the Circuit, he looks to build on the momentum that he has built after only the third event at the Horseshoe Indiana Circuit series. We will have to wait and see if the domination of the amateur player continues or if somebody like Evans can generate a second victory here in Indiana.

Notes on the Event

- Ninth place finisher Robert Georato was the only final table player to previously win a Circuit ring.

- The final table took just four hours to complete.

With his victory, Evans earns 50 points towards the Horseshoe Southern Indiana Casino Champion standings. The player who accumulates the most overall points in Horseshoe Southern Indiana's twelve combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives an automatic entry into the 2014 WSOP National Championship, as will the winner of the Horseshoe Southern Indiana Main Event. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. More information on the points system is available on WSOP.com.

With the fourth tournament now wrapped up, there are still eight more gold ring events remaining as the WSOP Circuit at Horseshoe Southern Indiana continues through October 14th.
