## Patty Hill Wins Her Second WSOP Circuit Ring Two wins in two years for the Brownsburg, IN native.

**Elizabeth, IN (October 6, 2013)** – At the 2012 Horseshoe Southern Indiana Circuit series, Patty Till defeated a field of 768 players to win the \$365 Re-Entry event. It was the first WSOP Circuit ring for the Brownsburg, IN native. Just over one year later, Till has earned yet another ring, this time in the \$365 No-Limit Hold 'em Turbo event.

A total of 108 players entered the fourth ring event at the Horseshoe Southern Indiana. The one-day event promised fast action and it did not fail to deliver. Less than eight hours into the tournament, we reached the final table. All eyes were on local favorite Till as well as the man they call "Rico".

Doug "Rico" Carli is a legend on the Circuit. Carli holds two Circuit rings, but is best known for the fact that he is the all-time cashes leader on the WSOP Circuit. This event marked the 78<sup>th</sup> time that Carli had finished in the money.

Carli had a tough time getting anything going at the final table that would end up running for about four hours. For Till, however, it was just the opposite. Despite entering the final table sixth in chips, Till quickly took control of the table. While Carli would end up finishing in fifth place, Till took a huge chip lead into heads-up play with Soutsakhone Bounmiswang.

Bounmiswang put up a battle, even taking over the chip lead at one point. However, Till quickly regained the lead when she flopped a set of fours against the A-10 of Bounmiswang. It took just a few more hands to Till to finish off her opponent.

With a crowd of locals gathered around the table, Till celebrated her second ring almost exactly one year from her last victory. "This is so exciting," Till exclaimed after her win.

Till doesn't want to wait another year for his next ring though. She will be back at it tomorrow, looking for number three.

## Notes on the Event

- The entire tournament took less than 12 hours to complete.

- This was Doug "Rico" Carli's record 78th career WSOP Circuit cash.

-Till is the first woman this Circuit season to take home a ring.

- The largest career cash for Patty Till came in 2008 when she finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the WSOP Ladies Championship for \$73,637.

With her victory, Till earns 50 points towards the Horseshoe Southern Indiana Casino Champion standings. The player who accumulates the most overall points in Horseshoe Southern Indiana's twelve combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives an automatic entry into the 2014 WSOP National Championship, as will the winner of the Horseshoe Southern Indiana Main Event. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. With the fourth tournament now wrapped up, there are still eight more gold ring events remaining as the WSOP Circuit at Horseshoe Southern Indiana continues through October 14th.
