Milan quickly proved he was no underdog early into the final table though, as he chipped up and never let his foot off the gas pedal, winning lots of uncontested pots. No fear was shown by Milan at the final table and he showed calmness and confidence all the way until the final card was dealt. Milan navigated through the tough final table and beat bracelet winner Justin Oliver heads-up to earn his first bracelet and shoot his WSOP earnings from \$3,056 to more than \$500,000.
