Sean Dempsey is the newest member of the gold bracelet club. Saturday evening, he managed to conquer the final table of the \$3,000 No Limit Hold'em event. He earned \$548,460 for the win, the largest live tournament cash of his career. This was Dempsey's second WSOP final table, his first coming last year in a \$10,000 PLO event in which he finished seventh.

Originally from Chicago, the 40-year old Dempsey was the chip leader going into the final table. You may not have heard of Sean Dempsey, but Tom "Durr" Dwan has. This married father of one, a doctor by trade, claims to have taught Dwan how to play Pot Limit Omaha. With his win in this event, Dempsey has proven that he is not only talented at PLO, but can also hold his own in No Limit Hold'em.
