That is exactly what Will Givens got today though, final tabling the same \$1,000 No Limit Hold'em event he took fourth place in just one week ago. The second chance at a bracelet proved to be a fruitful one, as the Denver, Colorado poker pro won his first gold bracelet and \$306,634.

Givens bested 29-year-old Miami-based pastry chef Angela Prada-Moed for the title just one week after appearing at the final table of the event of the tournament won by Dutch Boyd. He now has over \$400,000 in earnings from five cashes so far this summer.
