The mano a mano battle between Miscikowski and Szecsi topped off a tough final table in one of the more stacked fields of the summer. For the 28 year old Miscikowski, it is his first win at his first final table, but he has been posting consistent deep runs both live and online for several years.

Today, all that grinding paid off, and even the soft-spoken 28-year-old currently living in Costa Rica had to admit it was quite the personal accomplishment. "It feels great. This is one of the biggest sweats I've ever had," he said following his win. "It feels nice to come through."
