David Olson is the latest gold bracelet winner at the 2014 World Series of Poker. The 27-year-old professional poker player originally from Detroit topped an elite field of 122 players in the \$10,000 buy-in Limit Hold'em championship event. He collected \$303,909 in prize money in addition to his first gold bracelet.

Olson wasn't among the early favorites when final table play commenced on the third of three playing days. He ranked below average in chips, blending into a field crowded with talented opponents. However, Olson managed to seize the chip lead when play reached three handed and then steamrolled over his last two opponents on the way to his most satisfying career victory.
