Asi Moshe might want to think about hanging around the WSOP a little more often. His WSOP resume now features a first place and a fifth place with earnings more than \$700,000. His return on investment is now November Nine like after cashing in for another six-figure score in only his fourth ever played WSOP event. The sample size may be small, but there is no arguing that he has accomplished an impressive feat. Moshe collected his first gold bracelet by outlasting a field of 2,396 entries in the \$1,500 No Limit Hold'em event and collecting the top payday of \$582,321.

"Maybe the best feeling of my life," said Moshe when asked about how it feels to win a bracelet. "One of the very few dreams that I really wanted to accomplish but didn't think I really would, like going to the moon type of thing."

The 30-year-old from Tel Aviv, Israel plays online poker part time but now has the intention play a bit more live after another strong live performance. Moshe said he was aware of his lack of live poker experience and tried not read too much into tells and just focus on what he knew best about the game.
