Bell Gardens, Calif. (March 18, 2015). Josh Hale won the Pot-Limit Omaha tournament at the World Series of Poker Circuit at the Bicycle Casino, earning \$8,065 and his first WSOP Circuit ring.

Hale didnot play most of the events at this Circuit stop, but he made the most of his appearance in this event, which he considers his strong suit. % play more cash games than tournaments, +he explained after his victory. % play mixed-games, and I play PLO pretty regularly. +

The tournament was played over two consecutive days, starting Tuesday, March 17. Of the 79 entrants, only 6 returned on Wednesday for Day 2. Day 2 started at 1 p.m., and Hale secured his victory at about 4:30 p.m.

After this event, Scott Stewart retains the lead in the Casino Champion race. He has 72.5 points. Edward Liu is in second place with 60, and several players are tied for third with 50 points. The player who accumulates the most overall points in the twelve gold ring tournaments at the Bicycle Casino earns the title of Casino Champion and receives an automatic entry into the \$1 million 2015 WSOP National Championship. The winner of the Bicycle Casino Main Event earns an automatic entry to the National Championship as well. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the 50 at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season.
