Dylan Davis Wins First WSOP Circuit Ring in Turbo Event at the Bike

Davis, a poker dealer from Northern California, wins a ring in his first Circuit appearance.

Bell Gardens, Calif. (March 18, 2015) – The last gold ring event of the World Series of Poker Circuit at the Bicycle Casino is complete, and the winner of this stop's last ring is Dylan Davis.

This is the first WSOP Circuit event Davis has played, and he certainly made the most of it, finishing first and earning \$11,845. Even though this is his first Circuit event, Davis is certainly no stranger to the poker table. He works as a dealer at a cardroom in the Bay Area.

At one point during heads-up play, Davis was at a significant chip disadvantage to eventual runner-up John Apikian. However, patience and a familiarity with the tournament structure helped him overcome the deficit and earn the ring. "I just picked my spots. [...] I play 20 minute levels all the time, so this is normal for me."

The tournament was played out in a single day on Wednesday, March 18. Play began at noon, and Davis secured his victory at about 11:00 p.m.

After this event, Scott Stewart secured the title of Casino Champion at the Bike. He has 72.5 points. Edward Liu is in second place with 60, and several players are tied for third with 50 points. The player who accumulates the most overall points in the twelve gold ring tournaments at the Bicycle Casino earns the title of Casino Champion and receives an automatic entry into the \$1 million 2015 WSOP National Championship. The winner of the Bicycle Casino Main Event earns an automatic entry to the National Championship as well. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the 50 at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season.
