## **Rob Tannenbaum Wins His First Gold Ring**

Rob Tannenbaum comes away victorious in the Event #11 marathon final table.

West Palm Beach, Fla. (February 16, 2015) -- The WSOP Circuit series at the Palm Beach Kennel Club has finally come to a conclusion. The final day featured three tournaments. Day 3 of the Main Event, Day 2 of Event #11 and a one day turbo event. This tournament, Event #11 \$365 Noreturning for Day 2 with six players remaining and looked like it would be the clear favorite to finish first. However, that was not even close to being the case.

The final table began last night and returned today with six players remaining at 2 p.m. The tournament ended up finishing eight hours later at 10 p.m.

His patient play paid off in the form of his first career WSOP Circuit gold ring and the first place prize of \$12,879.

The 47-year-old is from Boca Raton, Florida. He used to play cash games more, but has shifted his focus to tournaments over the past few years.

Event #11 was the 11th of 12 gold ring events on the WSOP Circuit schedule at the Palm Beach Kennel Club in West Palm Beach, Florida, but last to finish. The \$365 Notournament attracted 159 players, generating a \$47,700 prize pool. The top 18 players were paid.

The tournament began Sunday at 3 p.m. and played 18 and half levels. Six players returned for Day 2 at 2 p.m. and the tournament concluded at about 10 p.m.

The player who accumulates the most overall points during the Palm Beach Kennel Club twelve combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives automatic entry into the WSOP National Championship set to take place at the end of the year.

All players who cash in ring events receive points that apply toward the Casino Championship race and the season-long race to claim one of 50 at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. More information on the points system is available
