Sam Greenwood is the latest gold bracelet winner at the 2015 World Series of Poker being held at the Flamingo Las Vegas.

The Toronto-based player won the \$1,000 buy-in No-Limit Hold'em tournament which was the 22nd event of the WSOP. He finished 1st in the final table with a \$318,977 prize, the biggest payday and most prestigious prize of his poker career, to date. His victory paid \$318,977 out of the total prize pool of \$1,723,500.

Cheered on by a loud rail of spectators, including several other poker pros, the player who describes himself as a "poker enthusiast" managed a bold comeback against Cole Jackson, who appeared to be the player to beat, but lost in the closing stages.

Greenwood said, "I just hope poker gives me enough of a steady income to do something later in life or what I want to do. I just hope poker gives me enough of a steady income to do something later in life."
