Jason Schwartz Wins Event #4 at WSOP Circuit at Planet Hollywood

After ten previous final tables, Schwartz now has his first WSOP Circuit ring.

Las Vegas (17 November 2015) – Jason Schwartz became the latest World Series of Poker Circuit ring winner on Monday. Schwartz, a native of Montana, earned his first Circuit ring and \$12,095 after winning Event #4: \$365 No-Limit Hold'em at Planet Hollywood in Las Vegas.

"I feel wonderful," Schwartz said after his victory. "I've been wanting to win one of these for a long time." Schwartz had come close many times in the past. He's made 10 WSOP Circuit final tables in the past, but the ring had eluded him until Monday.

Despite winning his ring in a hold'em tournament, Schwartz tends to focus on other poker games. "They keep my mind so active and interested," he said. "When it comes to hold'em I'm just learning to learning how to keep my mind active and focused on the smaller things at the table that are important."

The event attracted 144 players, creating a prize pool of \$43,200. The top 15 players made the money. Among those cashing in the event was two-time WSOP bracelet winner Susie Isaacs (11th place, \$886).

The tournament was played over the course of two days starting Sunday, November 15. Of the 144 entrants, seven returned for Day 2, which began at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, November 16. Schwartz earned his victory at about 4:45, making the final day a little less than three hours.

At the conclusion of this event, Brandon West retains the lead in the Casino Champion race. West, Jason Schwartz, and AJ Thompson all have 50 points, but West holds the tiebreaker (money earned). The player who accumulates the most overall points in the twelve gold ring tournaments at Planet Hollywood earns the title of Casino Champion and receives an automatic entry into the \$1 million 2016 WSOP Global Casino Championship. The winner of the Planet Hollywood Main Event earns an automatic entry to the Global Casino Championship as well. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the 50 at-large Global Casino Championship bids

awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. More information on the points system is available on WSOP.com.

Here is the list of gold ring winners from Planet Hollywood so far:

EVENT #1: Brandon West defeated 1,162 entries (\$580 No-Limit Hold'em Re-entry) for \$106,303.

EVENT #4: Jason Schwartz defeated 144 players (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em) for \$12,095

EVENT #5: AJ Thompson defeated 127 players (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em Turbo) for \$10,866.

With the third tournament now wrapped up, there are still nine more gold ring events before the WSOP Circuit at Planet Hollywood concludes on November 23.

All rings at Planet Hollywood are furnished by Jostens, the official ring supplier of the 2015-2015 WSOP Circuit season.
