Jim Juvancic Wins Pot-Limit Omaha Event at WSOP Circuit at Planet Hollywood

Juvancic wins his second Circuit ring and over \$10,000.

Las Vegas (18 November 2015) – Jim Juvancic won the pot-limit Omaha event yesterday at the World Series of Poker Circuit at Planet Hollywood. This is the second WSOP Circuit ring of Juvancic's career, and he earns \$10,801 for his first-place finish.

Juvancic was humble in victory, acknowledging that had he'd benefitted from some luck at the final table. "Whoever had my cards today was going to win this tournament," he said. "I'm completely happy with how I played, but any time I needed to win a hand or win as a 35% dog...the poker gods just wouldn't let me lose. I think I knocked out every person at the final table except one."

Juvancic earned his first WSOP Circuit ring less than a month ago, in the [HORSE event](#) at Horseshoe Hammond. He also had a runner-up finish at Hammond, and his ring victory here at Planet Hollywood is his fourth cash of this Circuit season. He now has 140 points on the Circuit's season-long [leaderboard](#), and is in good position to earn an at-large entry to the 2016 WSOP Global Casino championship.

The tournament was played over the course of two days starting Monday, November 16. Of the 120 entrants, 10 returned for Day 2, which began at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 17. Juvancic earned his victory at about 6:45 p.m., making the final day just under four hours.

At the conclusion of this event, Brandon West retains the lead in the Casino Champion race. West, Jim Juvancic, Rick Austin, Jason Schwartz, and AJ Thompson all have 50 points, but West holds the tiebreaker (money earned). The player who accumulates the most overall points in the twelve gold ring tournaments at Planet Hollywood earns the title of Casino Champion and receives an automatic entry into the \$1 million 2016 WSOP Global Casino Championship. The winner of the Planet Hollywood Main Event earns an automatic entry to the Global Casino Championship as well. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the 50 at-large Global

Casino Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. More information on the points system is available on WSOP.com.

Here is the list of gold ring winners from Planet Hollywood so far:

EVENT #1: Brandon West defeated 1,162 entries (\$580 No-Limit Hold'em Re-entry) for \$106,303.

EVENT #4: Jason Schwartz defeated 144 players (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em) for \$12,095

EVENT #5: AJ Thompson defeated 127 players (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em Turbo) for \$10,866.

EVENT #6: Rick Austin defeated 276 players (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em) for \$19,875.

EVENT #7: Jim Juvancic defeated 120 players (\$365 Pot-Limit Omaha) for \$10,,801

With the fifth tournament now wrapped up, there are still seven more gold ring events before the WSOP Circuit at Planet Hollywood concludes on November 23.

All rings at Planet Hollywood are furnished by Jostens, the official ring supplier of the 2015-2015 WSOP Circuit season.
