## **Kevin Davis Wins his 3<sup>rd</sup> Career WSOP Circuit Ring**

**After coming close twice last year, Davis wins the six-max event at the Horseshoe Tunica**

**Tunica, Miss. (26 January 2016)** – Kevin Davis won Event #6: \$365 No-Limit Hold'em Six-Handed today at the World Series of Poker Circuit at the Horseshoe Tunica. With this victory, David earns \$20,985 for first place and the third WSOP Circuit ring of his poker career.

While this is Davis's third ring, it's been a while since he's been in the winner's circle. His last ring victory came in 2011. He's come close a couple times in the interim, though. "I had two final tables at Southern Indiana," he said, referring to a WSOP Circuit stop back in October. "I was chip leader heading into one of them, but finished fifth."

This time, Davis started the final table in the middle of the pack, and ended up in first. He credits his success today with a change in perspective since his last final table. "I just had to relax," he said after the tournament. "I get to the final tables and I'm wound up, ready to get in there and box. I just had to calm down, and once I calmed down and said, 'have fun, enjoy being at the final table,' things just started flowing."

When there were four players left at the final table, Davis's chip stack got a big boost on a key hand. [He eliminated two players at once](#), leaving him heads up against James Ross. With momentum on his side, it was less than 45 minutes before Davis eliminated Ross to capture the ring.

Davis, a 45-year old contractor from Louisville, Kentucky, has now cashed five times this Circuit season, including three final tables and one win.

The tournament started Monday at 11:00 a.m. with 264 players. The top 27 finished in the money. When play concluded at about 1:30 a.m., there were seven players remaining. They returned Tuesday at 2:00 p.m., and Davis secured his victory before 5:00 p.m.

At the conclusion of this event, Andrew Brinkley retains the lead in the Casino Champion race. Brinkley now has 87.5 points from a one victory and one runner-up finish. After Brinkley, five players are tied with 50 points each. The player who accumulates the most overall points in the twelve gold ring tournaments at the Horseshoe Tunica earns the title of Casino Champion and

receives an automatic entry into the \$1 million 2016 WSOP Global Casino Championship. The winner of the Horseshoe Tunica Main Event also earns an automatic entry to the Global Casino Championship. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the 50 at-large Global Casino Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. EVENT #4: Josh Turner defeated 1,346 entries (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em Re-entry) for \$71,665.  
EVENT #5: Andrew Brinkley defeated 245 players (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em) for \$18,010  
EVENT #6: Kevin Davis defeated 264 players (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em) for \$20,895.

With the sixth tournament now wrapped up, there are now six more gold ring events before the WSOP Circuit at the Horseshoe Tunica concludes on Feb 1.
