## Glenn Casteel Wins the Final Event in West Palm Beach

Glenn Casteel wins the first WSOP event he ever plays in.

West Palm Beach, Fla. (November 23, 2016) -- Glenn Casteel has won the final event at the West Palm Beach Kennel Club series. He defeated a field of 72 players in the only turbo event of the series to score \$7,344 and his first WSOP Circuit gold ring.

The final event at the Palm Beach Kennel Club was the first WSOP tournament Casteel has ever played in and only the second tournament he has played at the Kennel Club since moving to Palm Beach Gardens one and a half years ago.

"This was awesome. This was very cool" said Casteel.

Casteel is the head of IT for a financial company. Things lined up perfectly for Casteel to play in this event. The job keeps him really busy, so he doesn't get to play a ton of poker, and the time he does have off he prefers to spend with his family. Casteel had some vacation time he needed to use. His kid was gone on an overnight field trip, so since the turbo was just a one-day event, he figured he would give it a shot.

The shot paid off and things continued to line up perfectly for Casteel. Casteel navigated through a field that included some of the best Circuit players, despite having a serious experience disadvantage.

Many of the Circuit regulars were playing this event after busting the Main to try and pick up some last minute points before the series was over. The field included gold ring winners Cody Pack, Russ Head, Robert Hankins and Brian Reinert.

Event #12 was the final of 12 gold ring events on the WSOP Circuit schedule at the Palm Beach Kennel Club. The \$365 No-Limit Hold'em Turbo Re-Entry tournament attracted 72 players generating a \$21,600 prize pool. The top eight players were paid.

The tournament was a one-day event. The tournament began at noon and finished about 9:30 p.m. midway through Level 22.

The player who accumulates the most overall points during the Palm Beach Kennel Club twelve combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives automatic entry into the WSOP Global Casino Championship set to take place at the end of the season.

All players who cash in ring events receive points that apply toward the Casino Championship race and the season-long race to claim one of 50 at-large Global Casino Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season.
