Because of this win and the \$20k that came with it, Lovelace decided on the spot that he was going to play in a second tournament this year. He didn't pick a little a tournament as his second tournament.

"I'm going to go play in the Main Event," said Lovelace.

Lovelace wants to take his prize money and go play in the \$10,000 Main Event in Las Vegas.

"It's a good time to give it a shot," said Lovelace.

Lovelace is an electrical engineer from Henderson, Tennessee. He works in critical power and many of the casinos in the area are his customers.
