SHAWN SPARKS WINS FIRST WSOP CIRCUIT RING

21 March 2018 (Tulsa, Okla.) – <u>Shawn Sparks</u> completed a dominating performance on Wednesday to earn the first World Series of Poker Circuit ring of his career. Sparks entered Day 2 of Event #6 (\$365 No-Limit Hold'em) at the Hard Rock Tulsa with a substantial chip lead, and made short work of his remaining opponents to earn the title and the \$13,284 first-place prize.

With four players left to start Day 2, Sparks had nearly half the chips in play, and he eliminated each of the other three players to secure the victory. The win was extra sweet, as he was here for his birthday weekend. He actually entered the tournament thinking that it was a one-day event, and it nearly was, since he made short work of the competition on Day 2. This is not only Sparks's first Circuit ring. It's also his first recorded WSOP cash. He remained humble in victory, acknowledging a few cards fell his way. "I got lucky twice to win this tournament, yesterday was KQ vs QQ. Smashed the turn with the joint. Today I got it in with 6-4 behind and hit the turn."
