STEVEN SNYDER WINS 3RD CIRCUIT RING IN CHEROKEE

Snyder moves over \$500,000 in career WSOP earnings with \$34,114 payday.

Steven Snyder has become a three-time WSOP Circuit ring winner with his victory today in Event #5 of Circuit Harrah's Cherokee, \$365 No-Limit Hold'em Six-Handed. With this win, worth \$34,114, Snyder logs his 45th WSOP cash and tops the \$500,000 mark in career WSOP winnings. More than \$450,000 of that total has come in Circuit events.

The triumph didn't come easy for the 38-year-old Snyder, who's best known for taking down the Circuit Harrah's Cherokee main event in October of 2016, for more than \$240,000. Snyder had to outduel nine-time Circuit winner Robert Hankins to win this event.

Snyder was almost ousted on Day 1, long before he emerged the victor from his dual against Hankins. Well into yesterday's action, Snyder lost all but six big blinds of his stack when an opponent rivered quad sixes against his set of kings, yet Snyder fought back for the win.
