DYLAN WILKERSON WINS HARRAH'S CHEROKEE MAIN

Wilkerson's second Circuit main event victory worth \$294,152.

San Francisco native Dylan Wilkerson has won the second WSOP Circuit main event of his poker career with a triumph in Event #10: No-Limit Hold'em \$1,000,000 Guarantee.

Wilkerson plays only occasional Circuit events and wasn't planning on playing at Cherokee, until good friend and fellow pro Joseph Cheong told of his own plans to travel to Cherokee, seeking qualifying points for this summer's Global Casino Championship. Wilkerson told Cheong, "Let's go to Cherokee. Why not?"

The impromptu decision turned out very well. This was the second Circuit Main Event ringwinning effort of Wilkerson's career, joining a win at the Bike in the Circuit's 2016-17 season. Since Cheong won Event #11 here in Cherokee, both friends depart the North Carolina mountains with Circuit gold.
