JOSEPH CHEONG WINS THIRD CAREER CIRCUIT RING

"subiime" earns \$34,188 in Event #11 triumph.

Popular Korean-born poker pro Joseph "subiime" Cheong has won the third WSOP Circuit ring of his career at Harrah's Cherokee, coming back from short-staked status midway through the final table to win this event's \$34,118 first-place money.

Cheong, 31, who now calls Las Vegas home, gained wide fame back in 2010 as part of the World Series of Poker Main Event's "November Nine," where he ultimately finished third for \$4,130,049. His career hasn't slowed down since, and with his third Circuit ring (in just 11 Circuit csahes), he's pushed his lifetime WSOP earnings to more than \$6.2 million.

Cheong's busy and successful poker career won't get any immediate breaks. He's battling for a spot in the Circuit series' Global Casino Championship, and he returns just nine hours after his win here to a mid-pack stack in Day 2 of the Cherokee stop's main event.
