WILLIAM KOPP WINS SECOND CIRCUIT RING IN EVENT 6

Professional poker player from Ohio wins Pot-Limit Omaha event at Cherokee

William Kopp is no stranger to mixed games, booking a win in Event #6: \$400 Pot-Limit Omaha for \$26,261 and his second Circuit ring.

"It feels good. Especially after a lot of close calls this year." Kopp is referring to his 11th place finish at the 49th World Series of Poker this past summer, pocketing \$52,626 in the \$10,000 Pot-Limit Omaha Championship. When asked if he's a mixed game player, specifically in the four-card realm, he said, "I wouldn't say it's my game, but I feel comfortable. I'd say I'm a hybrid – I can play anything."

Kopp took up the game of poker early on. "When I was a kid I'd play at the kitchen table with the family. When I turned 18 I started traveling and playing wherever I could play at that age." The two-time Circuit winner travels wherever he can drive to, and plans to see if he can rack up some more points this week.
