Poker pro from Florida wins ring #5 in Event 12, chip leading Main Event

A familiar face on the Circuit is Jeff Trudeau, a poker pro from Florida. He already has four rings, so coming into this event final table was something he was all too familiar with. Trudeau won \$39,640 after topping a field of 572 entries for a prize pool of \$188,760.

Trudeau has been playing professionally for many years and has a history for bagging chip leads at the end of Day 1s. The same rings true here at Cherokee, has he has a massive stack to end Day 1A and still end up as the overall chip leader across two starting flights. Look for Trudeau to make a massive run in the Main Event after his 26<sup>th</sup> place finish this last summer in Las Vegas.
