ERIC FRANK WINS 1st WSOP CIRCUIT RING IN EVENT #4 OF FOXWOODS SERIES

Connecticut schoolteacher Eric Frank wins 1st WSOP Circuit ring after a very successful summer on the felt

Eric Frank has just secured his first World Series of Poker Circuit ring after besting a field of 275 players in the \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Semi-Turbo event at Foxwoods for \$90,750.

Frank is a school teacher from Hartford, CT who has really capitalized on his summer vacation from school by going on a wild heater in poker. Leading up this even, Frank had more than doubled his total lifetime poker earnings in the last three months alone after many deep runs at casinos here on the east coast. Today's win will once again more than double that total.

Frank also won not one but two \$10,000 seats into the 2018 World Series of Poker Main Event, one of them right here in the Foxwoods Satellite held in June. Frank played one of the seats and gifted another to a friend. Frank made it all the way to Day 3 of the Main Event but ultimately finished just shy of the money.

"It's hard during the school year to play much poker, so I really dedicated this summer to playing, and I was fortune to have some success," a very humble Frank concluded.
