GREG HIMMELBRAND SHIPS 3rd CIRCUIT RING IN THE ONLY NON-HOLD'EM EVENT OF THE SERIES

Greg Himmelbrand is newest inductee into the three-Circuit-rings club

Greg Himmelbrand is the newest member of the three World Series of Poker Circuit rings club after winning the only non-Hold'em event of the Foxwoods series, Event #8 (\$400 Pot-Limit Omaha) for \$8,303.

Himmelbrand says that he plays a lot of PLO cash, but rarely plays in tournaments. He decided to enter this one because he had already cashed deep in a few events this series and decided he wanted to go for the Casino Champion points. Himmelbrand held the chip lead coming into the final table and maintained it pretty much wire-to-wire. When it came down to the heads-up battle between him and Soheb Porbandarwala, Himmelbrand had to fight it out against a tough competitor for nearly two full hours before finally sealing the deal.

Himmelbrand won his first World Series of Poker Circuit ring in the 2015/2016 \$365 No-Limit Hold'em Re-Entry tournament in Baltimore, MD for \$82,864. His second ring came at one of the Circuit's biggest stops where he took down the \$580 One-Day No-Limit Hold'em tournament for \$36,899. Today, he joins the elite club of three-ring winners and adds another \$8,303 dollars to his nearly \$1.7 million in lifetime earnings.
