ROBERT SHELDON TAKES HOME 1ST GOLD RING

Kitchen Manager decides to gamble at Horseshoe Southern Indiana and comes out ahead.

Robert Sheldon is the newest owner of a World Series of Poker gold ring. The Kitchen Manager from Lexington, Kentucky ultimately outlasted a field of 176 entries in Event #7: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em. The tournament took two days to complete at the Horseshoe Southern Indiana Circuit stop, leaving Sheldon as the last man standing.

Christian Mascagni was Sheldon's final opponent. The two remained evenly stacked for a good period of time. Then, when Mascagni shoved preflop after a raise from his opponent, Sheldon chose to toss it in and gamble.

"He was catching a lot of hands, and then finally the tide turned, and I just decided, when he raised, to kind of go for it and just see what happened," Sheldon explained.

Mascagni held ace-queen against Sheldon's suited six-five. Making a pair of sixes, Sheldon scooped the massive pot, left Mascagni crippled, and claimed the victory shortly after.

"I don't do a whole lot of tournaments. I mostly play cash," said Sheldon "I come and play here every once in a while... so I figured I come here and have some fun."

Winning is certainly a surefire way to a good time. Along with the debut gold ring, the recreation cash-game player also took home \$15,681. The score marks Sheldon's first cash on the WSOP scene.
