TYLER PAYNE WINS 1st WSOP CIRCUIT RING IN TULSA

Tyler Payne wins his first WSOP Circuit ring one month after getting married.

Tyler Payne won his first career World Series of Poker Circuit ring Thursday evening with a victory at the Horseshoe Hammond Casino. Payne came into Day 2 as the chip leader and had a smooth ride to victory "It felt like it was mine the whole time, no tough spots or bad beats."

Payne beat a stacked final table that concluded with defeating bracelet winner Kevin Eyster. "I thought I missed my opportunity at Cherokee when I bluffed it off in 7th.. I was wondering when I would get another opportunity, and to come right back and redeem myself, feels great"

Tyler Payne won his first WSOP Circuit ring but it wasn't the most important ring he received this year. One month ago Payne married his wife Korissa. "She one hundred percent supports me the whole way"

Payne, from Fayetteville NC, won Event #9: \$1,125 No-Limit Hold'em, earning \$45,900 for his victory.
