## KEN BAIME WINS 1<sup>ST</sup> WSOP CIRCUIT RING IN HAMMOND

The third times a charm for Ken Baime as he wins the final event of the series.

Ken Baime, from Glenview IL, just won his first World Series of Poker gold ring after finishing runner up in his last two final table appearances. Baime finished second in Event #5 at Harrah's Cherokee as well as second at Horseshoe Indiana last month. Though he's racking up the Global Casino Championship points he's thrilled to finally have a first place score.

The day started off pretty rough for Baime "The first couple of orbits were some of the most ridiculous beats I've ever taken. I was almost out in level 2" Baime turned it around however "I churned along, won a couple of big pots and stayed steady for a while."

Baime was the chip leader when there were two tables left and held that lead for most of his wire-to-wire victory.

Baime takes home \$16,559 for victory in the final event of the series. "I've been wanting this so bad, seriously"
