ANDREW ROBINSON REPEATS FOR 6TH GOLD RING

Just 24 hours after winning his fifth Circuit title, Andrew Robinson goes back-to-back for gold ring number six.

Andrew Robinson cruised to another World Series of Poker title on Wednesday, winning back-to-back tournaments at the Choctaw Durant Circuit series. The 38-year-old Poker Pro had just claimed his fifth gold ring 24 hours prior, by topping Event #7. Immediately after his victory, Robinson registered for Event #9: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Double Stack and once again ran away with the whole thing.

Robinson managed to bag an above average stack on Day 1 of Event #9, which drew a field of 429 entrants. Playing with confidence, he chipped up on Day 2 and broke through to the final-10 players as second in the counts.

"I think confidence is pretty key," stated Robinson. "I mean, when you are running good it exudes from you and kind of makes people a little scared to play against you, so it makes things easier.

During the final stretch, Robinson began to rake in chips like a high-powered magnet. By the time heads-up action was reached he was in a great position to take it down.

"I mean, I just had monsters a lot," Robinson mentioned "I was all in with queens, or kings, or aces, like five, or six, times."

The string of lucrative whole cards left Robinson with a huge chip advantage against his final opponent, Glen Goldsmith. Goldsmith could not overcome Robinson's wall of chips and had to settle for the runner-up spot.

Robinson picked up his sixth ring and \$31,146 for the victory. With another first-place finish at the current Choctaw Circuit series, Robinson also gained another 50 points, giving him the lead in the race for Casino Champion.

The Texas resident sits atop the venue leaderboard with 110 points. Robinson revealed that he has played in the "National," now "Global," Casino Championship a few times in his career. In fact, the Poker Pro has even won the Choctaw Casino Champhonors once before, back in 2013, and now looks to do it again in 2019.
